

■ ISK Only


■ Provider Network Only







ISK Persons Served by Population




ISK Persons Served by Age Group












Persons receiving a Pre-Admission Screening for Psychiatric Inpatient Care for whom the disposition was completed within 3 hours




New persons receiving a completed Biopsychosocial Assessment within 14 calendar days of a non-emergency request for service




New persons starting any needed on-going service within 14 days of completing a non-emergent Biopsychosocial Assessment



Persons discharged from a Psychiatric Inpatient Unit who are seen for follow-up care within 7 days




Persons readmitted to an Inpatient Psychiatric Units within 30 calendar days of discharge from a Psychiatric Inpatient Unit




New persons receiving a completed Biopsychosocial Assessment within 14 calendar days of a non-emergency request for service



New persons starting any needed on-going service within 14 days of completing a non-emergent Biopsychosocial Assessment


















Children with Serious




- # of SED Discharged
- % with Significant Improvement (20 points or more) in CAFAS from Intake to Discharge







