Ms. Meints has been employed by ISK for 24 years and has served in leadership roles for all population groups served by ISK, including adult intellectual and developmental disability services, adult mental health services, substance use disorder services, and youth and family services. She has most recently served as ISK's **Administrator of Clinical Services for the past five years**.
